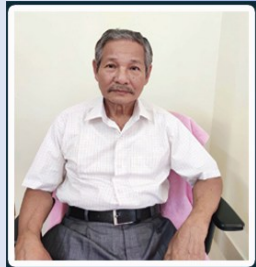

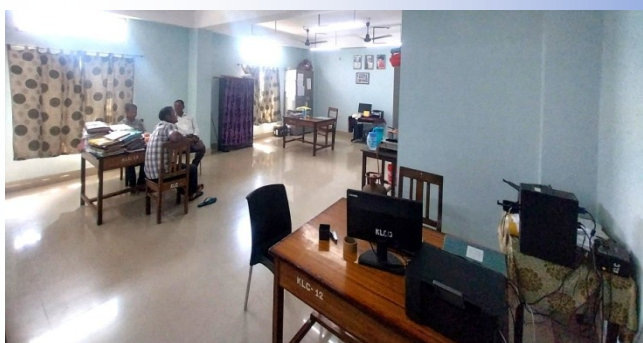
Infrastructure of the College

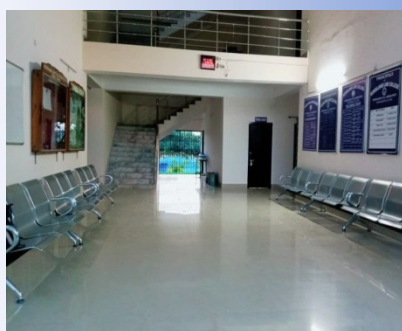

Rules and Regulations

Admission Procedure in 3 years LL.B. Course

The Bar Council of India Legal Education Rules 2011 No. 5: (a) **Three Year Law Degree Course:**

An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State legislature or an equivalent national institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for a three years' degree program in law leading to conferment of LL.B. degree on successful completion of the regular program conducted by a University whose degree in law is recognized by the Bar Council of India for the purpose of enrolment.

An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of Knowledge from a university established by an Act of Parliament or by a state legislature or from an equivalent national institution recognized as a deemed to be University or from a foreign university recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for a three year law degree course leading to conferment of LL.B. degree on successful completion of the regular course. Provided that applicants who have obtained First Degree Certificate after pursuing studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered eligible for admission in the 3yr. law degree course.

An application for admission for the LL.B. course will be done through the Regional SAMARTH of Assam State Higher Education Admission portal under the supervision of the office of the Principal, Kokrajhar Law College as per the public notification. The candidate will be given admission only upon qualifying the Common Admission Test conducted by Gauhati University.

Steps for Application into Regional Samarth Portal of Assam State Higher Education

For the first time the law aspirants shall appear in the COMMON ADMISSION TEST. ALL THE ASPIRANTS MUST MANDATORILY REGISTER AT THE SAMARTH PORTAL THROUGH THE LINK GIVEN BELOW:

1. Register at <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/cat/> by giving the required information.
2. Log in using the same email id/mobile no. and password.
3. Follow every steps for creation of profile and other required information.
4. Upload the necessary documents wherever asked.
5. Candidate appearing in 6th Semester examination of UG course and awaiting result shall select the status as appearing and awaiting result. Those who have passed the UG course shall select passed and provide the testimonials.
6. After all the steps the candidate shall pay the fee.
7. Candidate shall download the admit card using the same log in credentials and check the center , date and other information given in the admit card for appearing in Common Admission Test (CAT).
8. The candidate must wait for the result and follow the necessary steps for admission.

SELECTION PROCEDURE —

All the candidates on qualifying the Common Admission Test and willing to opt Kokrajhar Law College for pursuing of 3 years LL.B Programme must contact office of KLC in the contact details provided in the cover page of this prospectus.

Eligibility:

The applicant must be Graduate in Three years Degree Course from any discipline eg; BA, B.SC, B.COM, B.TECH, etc. securing a minimum pass percentage of 45% marks for General category candidates and 42% marks for OBC and 40% marks for S.C./ S.T. to be able to pursue professional degree in law (LL.B) at Kokrajhar Law College under Bodoland University.

Test Centres:

1. Candidates will be able to appear in any one of the following **CAT for 3-year Law Programme (s) 2026** Centres.
2. The same shall have to be indicated while filling out the online form. A candidate has to select any three test centres.
3. A candidate will be assigned one of the test centres stated below. Candidates will be allotted test centres based on their preference, subject to availability.

4. In case of unavailability of seats at their preferred test centre, the candidate will be allotted a test centre, subject to feasibility and availability. The University's allotment of centres shall be final and binding on the applicants, except otherwise decided by the competent authority on a case-to-case basis.

Other Details of CAT for 3-Year Law Programme, 2026:

1. All questions will be of the MCQ type with four alternative choices, of which only one answer will be the correct option.
2. The test Booklet and the OMR will be in English. The test will be OMR-based.
3. For every right answer, 4 marks will be awarded, and for every wrong answer, 1 mark will be deducted. There will be no marking for un-attempted questions.
4. Merit list will be prepared only on the basis of marks obtained in **CAT for 3-year Law Programme, 2026**. In case of a tie. i.e. when two or more candidates obtain equal marks, the inter-se merit of such candidates shall be decided as follows:
 - (i) Resolution by finding the ratio of positive marks and negative marks. The candidate with the higher absolute value of the ratio will receive a better rank.
 - (ii) Resolution by the number of unanswered questions. The candidate with fewer unanswered questions will be placed higher in rank.
 - (iii) If the resolution is not possible after this criterion, candidates with a higher age will be given a better rank.
 - (iv) In case the age is the same, then the percentage of marks obtained in HS or 12 standards shall be considered, and the applicant with the higher percentage (irrespective of the board or stream of study; Science, Arts, Commerce, etc.) shall be considered.
 - (v) In case the HS percentage is the same, then the percentage of marks obtained in class 10th shall be considered, and the applicant with the higher percentage (irrespective of the board) shall be considered.
5. Reservation and relaxation policy will be as per existing government of Assam norms.
6. Eligibility criteria will be verified by the respective colleges/institutions before admission.
7. A candidate cannot claim a seat without fulfilling the eligibility criteria of the Bar Council of India (BCI), even though his/her name appears in the merit list. The college/Institution will be held responsible for any violation of eligibility criteria and applicable BCI norms.
8. Application and Entrance Examination (CAT) Fee: **Rs. 1500/-**
9. Anything not covered in these guidelines will be decided by the University authority at the appropriate level.
